Who is like the celestial tree which fulfils all our desire, the protector of the devotees, salutations to the elephant faced One.

Holding your hand the noose and discus, gracefully riding the mouse You are pure and bright like millions of flames of fire, with the splendour of the sun. And you are stronger than a million vajras (the most powerful weapon of Indra)

Decorated with a colourful garland, a net of devotion and a cresent moon on the forehead

One who is like the celestial tree which fulfils all our desire, the protector of the devotees, Salutations to the elephant faced one.

Shri Ganesh who is the past and future, oblations and who is worshipped by Bhrigu and Bhargawa (Rishis).

The One who has divine army, who is the trap of death itself Who is saluted by all the eight Lokpalas (protectors of the worlds) The One who is complete Braham (eternal divine principle), whose complexion is bright like the sun

Who is the masculine energy and the destroyer of the house of the demons

Who is like the celestial tree which fulfils all our desire, the protector of the devotees. Salutations to you the elephant faced One.

Who is the heroism of the universe, the sun of the universe who performs various tasks and who is holy


The destroyer and creator of the universe, who is worshipped here and there (by yantra and tantra)




## 5. Sri Amriteshwar Bhairava Stuti


#### Meaning

I bow to that Netranātha, Amṛteśvara, who is fond of His nectar producing third eye, and in whose glamorous body the nine openings are nine door-keepers, which are nine incarnations of [Dvāreśā] Gaṇeśa; whose heart is Gaṇeśa, His son, the director of the one hundred Vāstu Devatā; whose five sensations are the five classes of Masters; whose mūlādhāra cakra consists of the ten layers of vāyu, which fill the universe; who is the Lord of Consciousness, always united with His energy of Consciousness; whose six limbs are His six universal attributes, all-knowingness, complete fullness, eternal knowledge, absolute freedom, inexhaustible energy, and infinite energies; and whose ten internal organs are the ten protectors of this world protecting it from all ten sides. (17)

Where in whose worship the misery of this universe is brought to an end and the possession of the wealth of salvation appears; where the lotus of the heart blooms and the Supreme blissful state flows from all sides, let that worship be glorified always. (18)









## 6. Karpur Gauram Mantra X 11 Times


#### Meaning-
